You are encouraged and welcome to become a part of our church family. Here are three ways to become a member of Strasburg Baptist Church:

By Baptism - If you have prayed to receive Jesus Christ as your Savior (forgiver) and Lord (master) then you must follow Jesus' example in a believer's baptism (by immersion). This identifies you as belonging to Christ!

By church letter - If you feel led to transfer your membership from another Baptist Church, we encourage you to come forward during the invitation! Our church clerk will contact your former church requesting your letter of membership to be transferred to Strasburg Baptist.

By Statement of Faith - If you are currently a member of a different Protestant church, you can become a member of Strasburg Baptist Church by statement of your faith in Jesus Christ. (if your baptism was not by immersion you will need to follow Jesus' example in a believer's baptism)

If you feel led to make a decision, an invitation will be given during the worship service for you to make God's will known for your life. The pastor or one of the deacons will be there to help you. If you still have questions or need assistance we will be glad to visit with you. Please call the church office and we will schedule an appointment for you to speak with someone.
